There are two kinds of lobbying: direct lobbying, which is communication to a legislator or legislative staff, which expresses a view on a specific piece of legislation. That means things like office visits. Grassroots

lobbying is communication to the public that expresses a view about a specific piece of legislation and includes a call to action, such as telling the recipient to contact a legislator. With grassroots lobbying, please report on the time your team spent constructing the communication. Emails to the public asking for them to vote one way or another on ballot initiatives or referenda are considered direct lobbying.

Please limit your reporting to activities organized by your chapter specifically.
